

CAUCUS MINUTES  
TOWN OF RUTLAND  
January 16, 2018 6:30 p.m.

1. CALL TO ORDER. Chairman Mark Porter called the meeting to order. The attendance list is on file.
2. The rules of the caucus were reviewed.  
ELECT CAUCUS CHAIRMAN AND APPOINT TELLERS TO BE USED IF NEEDED. Deana Zentner/Richard Zentner nominated Peter Loughrin For caucus chairman. Nancy Nedveck/Peter Loughrin nominated Mark Porter for caucus chairman; hearing no further nominations, the nominations for caucus chairman were closed. The vote for chairman was Porter=28, Loughrin=13; Porter was elected to serve as chairman. Chairman Porter received volunteers to serve as counters in the event of a run off.
3. NOMINATIONS: TOWN SUPERVISOR - 2 POSITIONS TO BE FILLED. 4 NAMES ELIGIBLE TO BE ON BALLOT.  
The following residents were nominated for Town Supervisor position:

Deana Zentner = motion/second by Richard Knutson/Richard Zentner  
Geoffrey Hutchinson = motion/second by Amy Hutchinson/Ryan Seffrood  
Jim Lunde = motion/second by Milt Sperle/Dave Grueneberg  
Peter Loughrin = motion/second by Kim Sime/Heather Hill

Motion/second by Richard Zentner/Dave Grueneberg to close the nominations for Supervisor; motion carried unanimously.

As there were more than 4 candidates, a run off was held using paper ballots with each resident allowed to vote for no more than two candidates. The results are as follows.

Nedveck = 15  
Hill = 24  
Zentner = 13  
Hutchinson = 16  
Lunde = 10  
Loughrin = 3

The following candidates will appear on the April 3, 2018 ballot:. Since all candidates eligible to appear on the ballot were present and indicated that they would be completing all required forms, the ballot order was drawn. The names will appear on the ballot in the following order:
