

WHAT YOU NEED TO GET AN ABSENTEE BALLOT BY MAIL OR IN-PERSON ABSENTEE BALLOTS FOR THE April 6, 2021 Spring ELECTION

1. You must be a Registered Voter. If you have voted in the Town of Rutland before - YOU ARE ALREADY REGISTERED. If not, you may register online at www.myvote.wi.gov. You must have resided in the Town of Rutland for 28 days in order to register to vote.
2. If you are already a registered voter in the Town of Rutland, you may request an absentee ballot at www.myvote.wi.gov, or you may
- 3.. Send a written request for an absentee ballot to Town Clerk Dawn George:

Include your printed name, address, signature, and a copy of your photo ID - if you have previously voted an absentee ballot, the photo ID is not necessary.

DO NOT WAIT until the statutory deadline of Thursday, April 1, 2021 to send in your request! Because of possible delay in mail delivery, Clerk George suggests mailing an absentee ballot request no later than Friday, March 26, 2021, and returning your ballot by mail no later than Tuesday, March 30, 2021. All ballots must be received by 8:00pm on Election Day, Tuesday, April 6, 2021 in order to be counted.
It is not required that an absentee ballot be mailed back. In order for your ballot to be counted, it must be returned by 8:00 p.m. on April 6, 2021. If you do not wish to mail in your absentee ballot, please contact Clerk Dawn George by email (clerk@town.rutland.wi.us) or by phone 608-455-3925 for other options. There will be a ballot box available at the Town Hall only on election day for you to drop off your ballot.

TO VOTE IN-PERSON ABSENTEE (Early Voting) by appointment only. Please contact the clerk by phone (608-455-3925) or email (clerk@town.rutland.wi.us) to make an appointment. In person absentee voting will be held March 23, 2021 thru April 2, 2021 by appointment only.
