Bids will be publicly opened on April 8, 2024 at 1:00 p.m at the Town Hall located at 785 Center Rd. It is anticipated that the Bids will not be awarded until the Board meeting on April 10, 2024. The meeting on the 10th will begin at 6:30 p.m.

1. Project Description

The Town may choose to do only the highest priority roads, depending on cost and budget considerations. Proposals should be submitted as separate projects for each road and if a proposal is submitted for all roads it should be clarified. Bidders may wish to arrange a road inspection trip with the Town's patrolmen to better understand individual project needs and to prepare a more accurate quote. The possible candidates for 2024 seal coating are:

- 1. Hildreth Rd. double seal with 3/8" pea gravel. 1200'x18' starting at a point that is 1500' from Old Stone Rd.
- 2. Old Stone Rd from Center Rd to Lake Kegonsa 5400' x 22'. Please quote price for both gray and black FA3 fractured granite.
- 3. Oak Ridge Road 2700' south of County Road A. Please quote price for both gray and black FA3 fractured granite.

2. Specifications:

- Based on use of FA3 fractured granite. Please price both gray and black fractured granite.
- length and width of each road proposed
